

**NO-PARKING ORDINANCE
FOR OCHSNER ROAD**

The Town Board of the Town of LaFayette enacts the following ordinance this 11th day of April, 1983:

SECTION 1. Parking Prohibited on Ochsner Road.

No motor vehicle or other vehicle of any kind shall be allowed or permitted to park in the highway right-of-way of Ochsner Road in the Town of LaFayette, Onondaga County, New York, from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

SECTION 2. Erection of Signs.

"No Parking" signs shall be erected by the Town Superintendent of Highways along the entire length of Ochsner Road.

SECTION 3. The Ordinance to be Obeyed.

Any person operating a motor vehicle or other vehicle of any kind on Ochsner Road shall obey this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Penalties for Offenses.

Any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of \$10.00 for the first offense and a fine of \$25.00 for each offense thereafter.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication, as provided in Section 133 of the Town Law, and the required publication shall be in the Syracuse Herald-Journal.
